

Requirements for Application

+ English / Italian Proficiency - B2;

+ Taking the IMAT or the entry exam of the private university.

Applicants can study medicine in 13 public universities in Italy. And also, there are 4 high ranked private universities also in Italy between Euro 15,000 - 20,000 per year. Each of these private universities have their own entrance exam. The tuition fees for the public universities for medicine is from Euro 500 -2000 per year but it is possible to get the full scholarship. The entry exam for medical studies in public universities is called IMAT and is held in September.

Is it necessary to speak Italian during clinical training? Is there an Italian language course?

Since during the clinical training process, you will be communicating with patients, you must know Italian. In order to avoid communication problems during the clinical education period, students who receive English medical education in Italy are also given a free Italian course in the first years. In this way, you will not have any communication problems during your clinical practice with patients and hospital staff.

IMAT

You should get familiar with the following general information about IMAT;

- + The exam consists of multiple-choice questions
- + Exam consists of the areas of logical reasoning, general culture, biology, chemistry, physics and mathematics.
- + It has 5 choices and only one correct answer is accepted.
- + Total exam time is 100 minutes
- + A total of 60 questions are asked.

IMAT Exam Content and Question Distribution

The curriculum of the IMAT Exam, which consists of Logic, General Culture, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics parts, is almost identical to the curriculum in high schools. So students do not have excessive difficulty while studying. IMAT Exam question distributions are as follows.

Scoring and Examination Rules | What is IMAT Exam?

- ++1.5 points are given for a correct answer, -0.4 points for an incorrect answer and 0 points for an unanswered question.
- + A candidate who answers all 60 questions correctly in the exam gets 90 full points
- + Each candidate must score a minimum of 40 points to possibly obtain a place in a university.
- + Nothing other than a black ballpoint pen is allowed into the exam hall.

Who can take IMAT exam?

In order to take the exam, you must pre-register and register also pay the pre-registration and registration fee. In order to take the exam, only your personal information is required.

To list the application requirements for IMAT; to be a high school graduate, to have successfully completed the pre-registration process, to have passed the threshold of university entrance exams held in your home country and of course anyone who pays the IMAT fee can successfully take the exam.

Additional information that should be known is that IELTS certificate is not required to take IMAT exam.

Where and When is IMAT exam is held?

The exam is held once a year in the second week of September each year. The application for the exam is made in July. Pre-registration and consular procedures must be done until May at the latest.

Those who do not complete pre-registration, consular equivalence procedures and final registration procedures cannot take the exam. University preferences are made during registration, before the exam. Your exam location is usually the university of your first choice. Apart from this, you can take the exam in many parts of the world.

IMAT Exam in Summary | What is IMAT Exam?

UCAT

The University Clinical Aptitude Test is an entrance test accepted by a consortium of universities in the UK, Australia and New Zealand for entry into medical and dental degree programs. The exam tests a student's mental ability and his readiness to join a medical school. The UCAT and UCAT ANZ are two-hour computer-based tests, divided into five separately timed multiple-choice tests: Verbal Reasoning, Decision Making, Quantitative Reasoning, Abstract Reasoning, and Situational Judgement.

The 120-minute exam is designed to check "Clinical Aptitude", with questions that test the ethical as well as cognitive abilities expected of good medical professionals. The importance of the exam is indubitable in light of the fact that almost 27 out of the 34 Medical Schools in the UK require the UCAT/ UKCAT Scores as a part of their admission process. Even though the object of the test is to check the aptitude of the candidates, the questions range from verbal, quantitative and abstract reasoning to decision making and situational judgment. Coupled with heavy competition, it becomes almost impossible to secure a seat in a good medical school without proper and guided preparations beforehand. The UCATSEN is an extended version of the UCAT for those with documented disorders or disabilities. The exam is a must for all students planning to pursue a medical programme in the UK, which is needless to say, the best-in-class. The competition is vigorous, as is apparent from the fact that only about 30% of the applicants are accepted into medical schools. The rate is much lower for more prestigious colleges requiring a high standard of qualification. It thus becomes necessary to go for a result oriented guided preparation for the same.

BMAT

The BioMedical Admissions Test is an aptitude test used as part of the admissions process for Medicine, Biomedical Sciences and Dentistry in some universities in the United Kingdom, Singapore, Spain, Malaysia, Thailand, Hungary, Croatia and the Netherlands.

When can I take BMAT?

There are several BMAT sessions throughout the year and different universities accept different sessions, depending on their admissions cycle. It is important to know which one(s) you can take as part of your application.

SAT Digital Exam Syllabus 2024

SAT Syllabus includes courses that students have already covered in their school curriculum over the years. The syllabus for SAT exam includes:

- + Reading & Writing
- + Mathematics

Earlier on, SAT was testing reading and writing as two separate sections, but now there is one section only. Also, the science concepts are not really tested directly like the Maths section, but there would be passages in the reading and writing section which would cater to the Science subject coverage in SAT exam. There is no specific SAT syllabus for the science section.

SAT Reading section is a part of the evidence-based Reading and Writing part of the SAT. It has a total of shorter passages each having 10-11 questions and there will be a total of around 56 questions in the section. Each question has four answer choices. The reading comprehension part is designed to evaluate candidates' ability to understand the meaning of different contexts and their associated terms with meaning and to comprehend written text.

Types of Questions in the Reading & Writing Test

1. Craft & Structure

Students will be assessed for their comprehension, vocabulary, analysis, synthesis, and reasoning skills and knowledge to understand and use high-utility words and phrases in context. They would also be required to evaluate texts rhetorically and make connections between topically related texts.

2. Information & Ideas

Students will use comprehension, analysis, and reasoning skills and knowledge and the ability to locate, interpret, evaluate, and integrate information and ideas from texts and informational graphics.

3. Standard English Conventions

Students will use editing skills and knowledge to make the text conform to core conventions of Standard English sentence structure, usage, and punctuation.

4. Expression of Ideas

Students will use the ability to revise texts to improve the effectiveness of written expression and to meet specific rhetorical goals.
